The focus of this internship is to assist the Managing Director, Program and Business Development in developing an impact report for Rhode Island's climate resilience action strategy, Resilient Rhody. Secondly, candidates will work with the entire Business Development team on project origination for the Infrastructure Bank's stormwater and resiliency programs. Candidates will be encouraged to take on responsibilities that align with both their own personal interests and the pursuits of the organization.

An internship with the Infrastructure Bank is an exciting opportunity to gain valuable experience at the frontier of the emerging field of green banking in an innovative and supportive work environment.
